Principal Dentist Dr Robert Harper of volunteered the services of himself with 1 other dentist, 2 hygienist / therapist and 2 support staff.

8 patients were seen with most patient having an OPG taken and treatment plan. Treatment performed was examinations, scale and cleans, restorations, temporary restoration and radiographs. In total the amount of treatment performed was \$3757.00.

Further treatment is required still on patients with the hope they may attend another dental rescue day in the near future for treatment to be completed before their treatment needs become extensive. Two patients have been advised to seek further extensive treatment at the RDHM. Case Workers have been notified to assist with making further appointments.

The volunteering staff enjoyed their day. Additionally case managers and patients were very thankful and appreciated the support of the NDF. One patient was extremely thankful advising he had been living in pain for a number of years and today's treatment will benefit them greatly.
